



This Privacy Policy applies when you use our Services. We offer our users choices about the data we collect, use and share as described in this Privacy Policy and Cookie Policy.

Changes

Changes to the Privacy Policy apply to your use of our Services after the “effective date.” Quality Industrial Corp. can modify this Privacy Policy, and if we make material changes to it, we will provide notice through our Services, or by other means, to provide you the opportunity to review the changes. If you object to any changes, you may close your account.

Related Companies and Other Services

We receive data about you when you use some of the other services provided by us or our affiliates.

Service Use

We log your visits and use of our Services. We log usage data when you visit or otherwise use our Services, perform a search. We use log-ins, cookies, device information and internet protocol (“IP”) addresses to identify you and log your use.

Your Device and Location

We receive data from your devices and networks, including location data. When you visit or leave our Services, we receive the URL of both the site you came from and the one you go to and the time of your visit. We also get information about your network and device (e.g., IP address, proxy server, operating system, web browser and add-ons, device identifier and features, cookie IDs and/or ISP, or your mobile carrier). If you use our Services from a mobile device, that device will send us data about your location based on your phone settings.

Cookies and Similar Technologies

As further described in our Cookie Policy, we use cookies and similar technologies (e.g., pixels and ad tags) to collect data to recognize you and your device(s) on, off and across different services and devices where you have engaged with our Services. These technologies help us better understand user behavior, tell us which part of our website people have visited, whether an electronic marketing brochure is opened, facilitate and measure the effectiveness of advertisements and marketing materials and similar uses. Our use of cookies includes storing visitor preferences, recording session information, recording user-specific information on what pages of our website people have visited, customizing Web page content based on visitors’ browser type or other information that the visitor sends or based on



their behavior. Most browsers will automatically accept cookies. You can set your browser to reject cookies and certain other technologies. Please be advised that some parts of the Actelis web site may not function properly if the cookies or other technologies are rejected.

How We Use Your Data

We use your data to provide, support, personalize and develop our Services. How we use your personal data will depend on which Services you use, how you use those Services and the choices you make in your settings. We use the data that we have about you to provide and personalize our Services, so that our Services can be more relevant and useful to you and others.

Collection and Use of Non-Personal Information

We also collect and/or may create non-personal information – data in a form that does not permit direct association with any specific individual. We may collect, create, use, transfer, and disclose non-personal information for any purpose.

Surveys

Polls and surveys are conducted by us and others through our Services. You are not obligated to respond to polls or surveys, and you have choices about the information you provide. You may opt-out of survey invitations.

Service Providers

Legal Disclosures

We may need to share your data when we believe it's required by law or to help protect the rights and safety of you, us or others.

It is possible that we will need to disclose information about you when required by law, subpoena, or other legal process or if we have a good faith belief that disclosure is reasonably necessary. We attempt to notify Users about legal demands for their personal data when appropriate in our judgment, unless prohibited by law or court order or when the request is an emergency. We may dispute such demands



when we believe, in our discretion, that the requests are overbroad, vague or lack proper authority, but we do not promise to challenge every demand.

Change in Control or Sale

We may share your data when our business is sold to others, but it must continue to be used in accordance with this Privacy Policy. We can also share your personal data as part of a sale, merger or change in control, or in preparation for any of these events. Any other entity which buys us or part of our business will have the right to continue to use your data, but only in the manner set out in this Privacy Policy unless you agree otherwise.

Other Important Information

We monitor for and try to prevent security breaches. We implement security safeguards designed to protect your data, such as HTTPS. We regularly monitor our systems for possible vulnerabilities and attacks. However, we cannot warrant the security of any information that you send us. There is no guarantee that data may not be accessed, disclosed, altered, or destroyed by breach of any of our physical, technical, or managerial safeguards.

Lawful Bases for Processing

We have lawful bases to collect, use and share data about you. You have choices about our use of your data. At any time, you can withdraw consent you have provided by going to settings.

We will only collect and process personal data about you where we have lawful bases. Lawful bases include consent, contract and “legitimate interests.”

Where we rely on your consent to process personal data, you have the right to withdraw or decline your consent at any time and where we rely on legitimate interests, you have the right to object.
